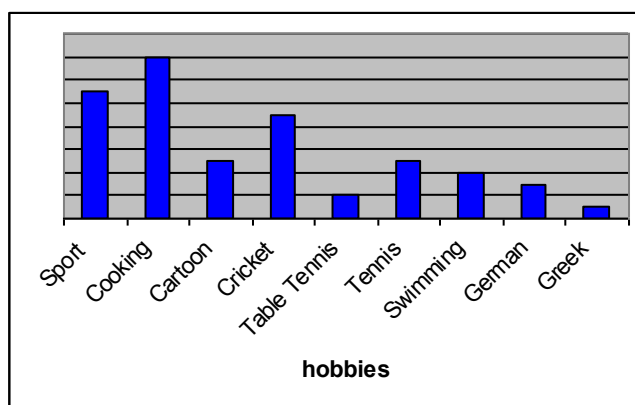
Darcy:

Poor man's pizza

This is a great snack for weekends or when you
come in from school.

Ingredients

2x wraps (like those used in fajitas)
Tomato puree - half a tube should be plenty
Approx 100g cheese - e.g. cheddar, mozzarella,
edam

Fillings of your choice - e.g. chicken, ham, toma-
to, pepperami stick, mushrooms, sweet corn,
peppers

Place wrap on a plat or flat surface
Spread the tomato puree over the entire wrap,
spread it thinly

Cut up your chosen ingredients and place them
evenly over half of the wrap

(so you have a semi-circle with food on)
Grate the cheese and sprinkle over the top of
you other ingredients fold the wrap in half to
cover all the toppings

Place in a sandwich toaster, Panini maker or
George foreman and cook until golden and crispy
- take care that the cheese doesn't spill out!
