FOUNDATION SUBJECTS (Autumn term)



COMPUTING

In computing, topics covered include, logging in, navigating the 'Purple Mash' programme, Purple Mash tools, sorting tool and pictograms.



STONE AGE

In our Stone Age topic this first half term the children will be learning about:

- Stone Age cave art
- Stone Age jobs
- Stone Age houses
- Stone Age animals
- Comparing modern day and Stone Age objects



ART

This term the children will be creating their own Stone Age cave art using oil pastels.



The children will also be creating self-portraits through observational line drawing and adding colour with coloured pencils.



After half term they will be learning about the art of Giuseppe Arcimboldo and re-creating their own self-portraits inspired by his work.

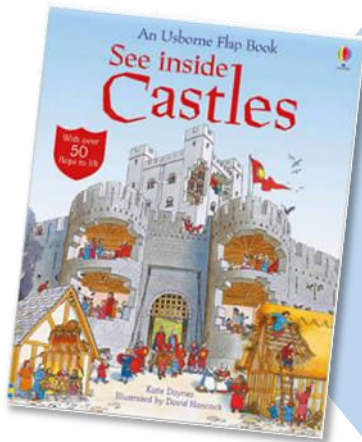
DESIGN TECHNOLOGY

The children will be designing and building their own castles using junk modelling. The children will learn different techniques to join materials. We would be grateful if you could bring in any boxes, cartons, cardboard rolls, etc. after half term for the project.

CASTLES

After half term we will be covering our second history topic, 'Castles'. The children will be learning about:

- Castle architectural features
- Types of castles
- Geographical locations
- Jobs inside a castle
- Designing and making a castle
- Creating a coat of arms
