

NURSERY FEES AND THE UNIVERSAL ENTITLEMENT TO GOVERNMENT-FUNDED CHILDCARE

Government-Funded Childcare Entitlement

- All three- and four-year-olds are entitled to 15 hours a week (3 hours per day) of government-funded childcare during term time.
- The entitlement is available for six terms starting the term after the child's third birthday until the term of their fifth birthday.
- At Ripley Court the funded hours are offered in the afternoons, Monday to Friday.

How to Claim Funding

- Parents/guardians must complete and sign a Declaration Form, sent out by the School before the end of the previous term.
- Completed forms should be emailed to rcfees@ripleycourt.co.uk
- The School cannot claim the funding without the completed form.

Fee Structure for Parents/Guardians Claiming the Universal Entitlement

AM Sessions	£440	£2,205
PM Session (Funded)	£0	£0
PM Ripley Plus Charge	£215	£1,075
Total Full Day Charge	£655	£3,275

Note: Under government guidelines, the Ripley Plus charge is a voluntary charge. We request this of parents to cover the costs of providing the extended curriculum and use of the wider school facilities.

Reception Class Fees (Children Under 5 Claiming Funding)

For children under 5 during their Reception Year and claiming the universal entitlement, the termly fee structure is as follows:

Termly Fee 1 September 2026 with Funding	£3,670

The School's approach to funding is reviewed regularly and may change in line with Department for Education guidance.
