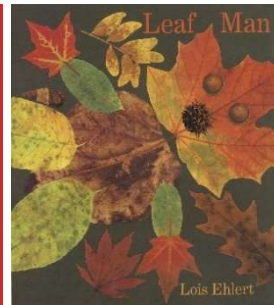
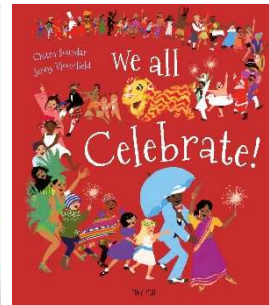
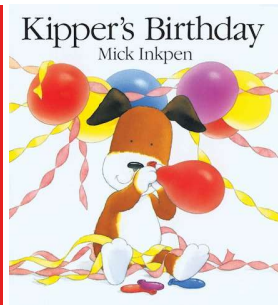
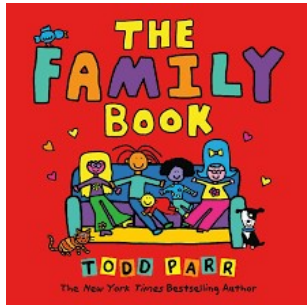


Reception Knowledge Organiser: Autumn 1: Let's Celebrate

How can you learn at home?

 Practise name writing and letter formation in lots of different ways. Celebrate all the wonderful mark making your children produce.

★ write my name ★ make marks with meaning ★ write labels ★ talk about what might happen next ★ share my ideas in a group ★ listen to stories

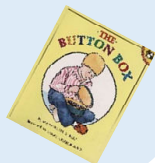
Maths
