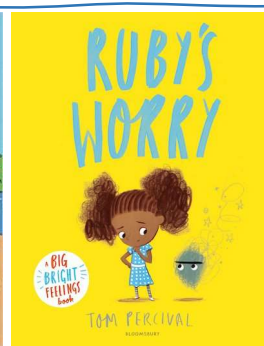
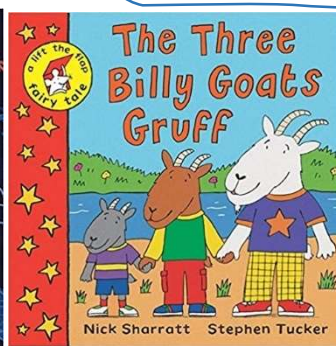
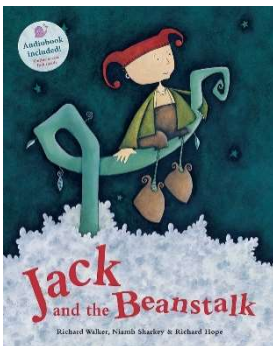
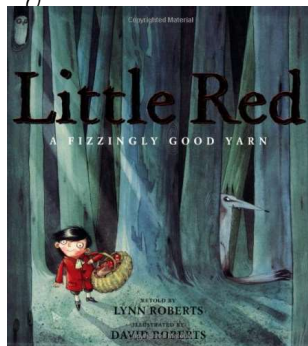


Reception Knowledge Organiser: Spring 1: Once Upon a Time

cooking:

Apple crumble, pastry beanstalks, bread rolls, gingerbread men, Chinese noodles



How can you learn at home?



Read and share traditional tales. Talk about the plot in a story, the characters and make predictions about what may happen next. Create and tell oral stories building up imaginative language.



Write lists for shopping, make mini story books, write cards and invitations. Encourage the use of new taught sounds and spelling tricky words (green/red words)



Play number games, find the total of groups of objects and practise subtracting from groups too. Quick recall games are great for number bonds and doubles facts. Play with money, look at it, describe it, sort it and use it.



Talk about Winter and what happens to plants and animals. Care for house plants or plant seeds and nurture their growth.



Literacy

Each week will be focused on a traditional tale. Key skills will be developed through reading, exploring and retelling the story.

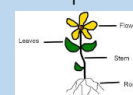
