Year 6 Science trip to The Natural History Museum, Tring

On Tuesday 3rd March 2026, the Year 6s will be visiting the Natural History Museum's site in Tring. Here they will be engaging in a workshop on adaptation and natural selection as part of this topic in Science. There will also be an opportunity to view the exhibits and enjoy some of the outdoor areas. As we will be out for most of the day, we will enjoy a picnic lunch on site before heading back to Ripley.

We will be travelling to and from Tring by coach, leaving promptly at 9am and returning to school by 4pm. The children will be provided with a packed lunch, so will need to bring their school backpacks and a filled water bottle. The children are to wear full school uniform, including blazer. Please ensure they also have their waterproof school coat. If it is wet on the day, we will ask the children to wear their trainers, so please make sure these are at school.

There is a shop at the museum so the children may bring a small amount of money with them – we suggest no more than £10 in a named zipped purse.

The cost of the trip will be £18, which will be added to the Summer Term bill. If your child is ill or cannot make the trip, I am afraid the school cannot offer any refunds. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to ask.
