

SUMMER TERM 2026 – EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Club bookings will be open on **Thursday 12th March at 7pm**. Please access the Parent Portal to sign your child up to the desired club. Please note, if you enter your password incorrectly three times, the system will block your account for a short period (5 to 10 minutes).

Club bookings will close on **Thursday 19th March at 10am**.

PLEASE NOTE:

Once club bookings have closed, our administrative processes and staffing are confirmed based on those numbers. If you wish to make changes to a booking or withdraw a pupil after the booking deadline, we will now be applying an administrative fee of £5 for each change made. This will help us cover the additional time and costs involved in adjusting registers and payments and liaising with club instructors and teaching staff who need to be kept informed of all the club timetable amendments. We appreciate your understanding and encourage families to check their selections carefully before the booking window closes.

Please note your booking is a commitment for the entire Summer Term and you will be charged for the entire term. The full charge and any administrative fees will be added to your Autumn Term Fee invoice in arrears.

TIMINGS

Wraparound Care will run from Breakfast Club on the first day of term and the last session will be Breakfast Club on the last day of term. Prep and after-school care will not be available on the last day of term.

Clubs will start on **Monday 20th April 2026**, except for Judo, which will run **Wednesday 15th April** and M:Tech on **Friday 17th April**.

Clubs will run until **Friday 3rd July 2026**. No clubs will run in the final week of term

In the Summer Term, we have our much-anticipated Activities Week from 15th June to the 20th June. **Extra-curricular clubs will not run this week**, except for Monday swimming lessons with Mrs Ballantine.

There may be occasions when specific activities cannot occur due to other school functions or staff unavailability. If this is the case, we will inform you as soon as possible and billing will be adjusted accordingly.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

- A minimum number of pupils are required for Clubs to run (as noted in the table); if the threshold is not reached, the club will not run.
- There will be a maximum of 8 (9 for Judo) sessions this term.
- We will endeavour to give you at least 24 hours' notice if a club needs to be cancelled, and billing will be adjusted accordingly.
- Clubs are available on a first-come, first-served basis.
Some clubs have limited numbers, and if full, you can add your child's name to the waiting list. If your child is on the waiting list, the Clubs Coordinator will advise you if a space becomes available, and you can choose to take the available space or decline it.
- Due to recent government legislation, all extra-curricular clubs now include 20% VAT.

WRAPAROUND CARE

Breakfast Club (all pupils)

The Breakfast Club runs Monday to Friday from 7.30 am – 8.00 am. Please drop your child off in the Dining Room, and the staff on duty will sign your child in; advance booking is not required.

The cost is £4.80 per day.

Any pupil on site before 8am will be directed to Breakfast Club.

After School Club (Après School) Nursery & Little Court

Our after-school care is provided by Après School and runs for Nursery - Year 2 pupils from 15.30 – 18.00 daily. It provides a full and varied programme of activities and pupils are provided with a healthy snack and a drink. Athletics Development- Aspire to Greatness

Give your child the best start in their athletic journey with our Athletic Development Club. This signature programme, created by Kate Staples, former GB athlete and TV Gladiator, and Olympic legend Daley Thompson, focuses on developing foundational fitness and strength in a fun and holistic way.

Depending on the weather, the club will run on the field or in the Theatre/Sports Hall in adverse weather. Pick up for Upper Court will be from the field and Little Court children will be returned to Little Court for collection.

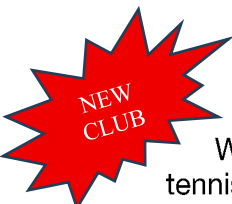

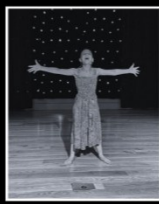

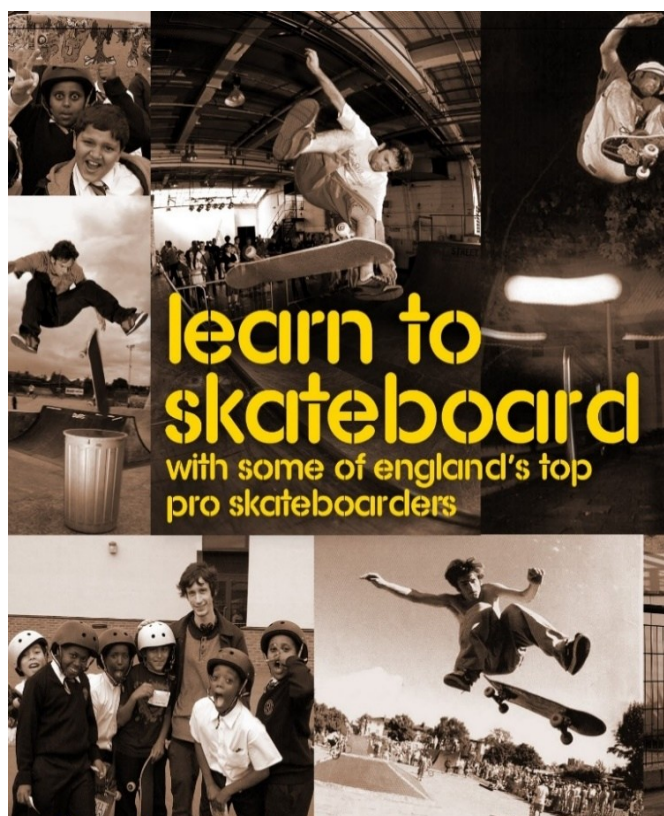
